La Ley Discussing Father's Rights With Attorneys Jenet Pequeno and Andrey Filipowicz

In August 2009, The White House invited Andrey Filipowicz as an expert resource for the First Annual White House Town Hall Meeting on Responsible Fatherhood and Healthy Families. In addition, he was honored by the Center for Missing and Exploited Children for success in litigating international child abduction cases. Most notably, he helped a desperate father in Mexico reunite with his son, who was abducted to the US by his mother.

Jenet Pequeno received national recognition for reuniting a father with his children after their mother abducted them to Texas to be with her lover. Passionate about fathers' rights, he has successfully represented clients from Ecuador, El Salvador, and Mexico.

Known for hard-hitting advocacy on behalf of fathers, attorney Jeffery Leving and his firm have reunited fathers and children since 1981. He helped reunite Elian Gonzalez with his father in Cuba, winning international support. On October 27, Leving and firm attorney James Hagler had a private meeting with State Department officials to provide strategic recommendations regarding international parental child abduction in Mexico and other countries.
