Dad has a strong bond with his five-year-old son. When his relationship with his child's mother fell apart, dad's peaceful world turned into a nightmare. In the middle of a bitter custody battle, his ex blindsided him with an emergency order of protection. Her accusations were false—but devastating. She painted dad as a danger to his own child.

Fearing that his ex sought to alienate him from his son to win custody, dad frantically called attorney Jeffery Leving for help. He was terrified of losing his little boy forever. He feared going to jail. Leving assured dad that our expert legal team would fight to protect them both.
