Leving to receive Biden presidential award, Senate proclamation

CHICAGO – Fathers' Rights attorney Jeffery M. Leving, who has waged a crusade for 40+ years standing up for fathers, will receive national and state recognition for his efforts at a speaking appearance on Sunday.

After the awards ceremony, Leving will give a speech about fighting for social justice, and then engage in a sit-down discussion with Sen. Harris on overcoming challenges and advancing the efforts of African-American fathers.
